Historical Marker

JustFundKY is proud to erect all three historical markers dedicated to Kentucky's rich LGBTQ history. The third marker is a commemoration of Lexington's 1999 Fairness Ordinance and stands directly outside city hall, showcasing Lexington as a welcoming city for LGBTQ people.

Powell County Public Library

JustFundKY helped bring LGBTQ literature to the Powell County Library, thus raising educational awareness in the region. With their grant money, the Powell County Library hosted LGBTQ speakers and created an LGBTQ section.

Aging Needs Assessment

JustFundKY supported the Kentucky LGBTQ Aging Needs Assessment, a first of its kind exploration of LGBTQ seniors in Kentucky.
